41st INTERNATIONAL WORKSHOP ON WATER WAVES AND FLOATING BODIES (IWWWFB)

April 26 -29, 2026, Plitvice, Croatia

You are warmly invited to submit an abstract and participate in the 41st International Workshop on Water Waves and Floating Bodies (IWWWFB), which will take place in Plitvice, Croatia, from April 26 to 29, 2026.

IWWWFB is an annual meeting of engineers, mathematicians, and researchers, focusing primarily on water waves and their effects on floating and submerged bodies. Abstracts may be accepted in related fields of specialty, provided they are sufficiently broad or profound to be of interest to this specific field. Abstracts should be of high quality in that new ideas are included in the analytical and/or numerical approaches developed. Purely experimental work should emphasize the underlying physics. Work that is still incomplete may be presented, but material already published and widely disseminated should not be reported.

- 1) Abstract Preparation and Submission: Authors are invited to prepare an extended abstract of no longer than 4 pages. Prospective participants should submit only one abstract as the first author. Abstracts should be submitted following the guidelines described on the local workshop website.
- 2) Abstract Review Procedure: All submitted abstracts will be reviewed by a scientific committee. Notifications regarding the acceptance status will be sent by January 31, 2026. Accepted abstracts will be published in the IWWWFB 2026 Proceedings and presented at the Workshop.
- 3) Oral Presentations: The Workshop will be held in person. Each speaker will give a concise presentation of approximately twenty minutes, followed by a five-minute discussion. As per Workshop policy, each participant is limited to **one presentation**.
- 4) Workshop Participation: The program will be organized as a single session to ensure full participation in all presentations. To foster an informal and collaborative atmosphere, attendance will be restricted to authors who have submitted abstracts.
- 5) Registration: Workshop registration will open on January 15, 2026. All individuals who have submitted an abstract, regardless of the outcome, are warmly invited to register and attend IWWWFB 2026.
- 6) The Tuck-Newman-Evans Fellowships: The Tuck-Newman-Evans Fellowships are intended to support participation in the IWWWFB by a student or young researcher. These fellowships are restricted to students and to young researchers who have completed a research degree within the three years prior to application.
